



What is it?







Evaluate Learning Progress

You can use Learning Progress to evaluate student progress in a Topic/Sub-topic along two distinct dimensions:

- 1. MASTERY: Marks scored by student (Awarded Marks)
- 2. **PRACTICE:** Total marks of all questions attempted by students tagged to the Topic/Sub-topic (Total Marks)



If PRACTICE in any area appears lacking, you can assign more questions or quizzes on the topic.
