"Why get Phygital?"

- To convert existing hardcopy resources or those in other formats (e.g. Word, Powerpoint, Google Docs, PDF) to use in SLS.
- Some students might benefit from a print-first approach, especially younger children and those who might be easily distracted with devices.
- As a fallback when there is no access to devices or Internet connectivity, but you still want to benefit from SLS pre- (e.g. Lesson Authoring) and postlesson (e.g. Data Capture) capabilities.

- Google Integration to allow easy embedding of existing resources in other formats.




In cases where students have no access to devices or the Internet, or you prefer them to use hardcopy resources, you can print any SLS Lesson as a Print-Friendly Worksheet.


