Teams

### Subgroups

What is...

A temporary group for students to work collaboratively on a particular Activity.

A semi-permanent group that allows teachers to quickly create Teams based on Subgroups.

How to...

Created from the Assignment Settings subpage when a teacher assigns a Lesson.


Created from the Admin tab in a Class Group.



Teachers can assign different groupings for different Activities.

Teachers can group students based on learning abilities in Full Subject-Based Banding (FSBB) classes.

Teachers can group students into different classes for large (e.g. level-wide) Class Groups.



#### How you can use Teams in the classroom:

- You can create segmented Polls and Interactive Thinking Tools that enable discussions within Teams.
- You can allow Teams to work collaboratively on a Team Quiz and submit a single response for the whole Team.
- You can differentiate instructions by limiting access to certain Activities to particular Teams of students for Differentiated Instructions.

- You can use Game Teams to encourage collaboration rather than competition.








#### Game Teams
